### **Sussex Air Ambulance**

Until June 2007 Sussex was one of the few counties in the UK that did not have its own dedicated Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS). The Sussex Air Ambulance Appeal was launched in June 2005 at Beachy Head in East Sussex. The appeal target was set at 250,000 and this total was achieved in December 2006 and the new Air Ambulance Service was launched in June 2007.

The new HEMS service is based at Dunsfold Park, on the Sussex, Surrey border and will be flying, fast and unhindered at over 150 mph to reach the whole of the County within a matter of minutes. It has a crew of highly trained doctors and paramedics on board, who can treat and assess the patient and then transport them to the nearest major hospital or specialist unit, in a fraction of the time taken by a land ambulance.

**At a annual cost of £1.5 million or £4,000/day**, support from the people of Sussex will be essential to **keep it flying, 7 days/week, 365 days/year** and give us all peace of mind should we ever need it.

Since the charity does not receive any funding from the Government or Lottery the support of the public is essential to the success of the Sussex Air Ambulance.
